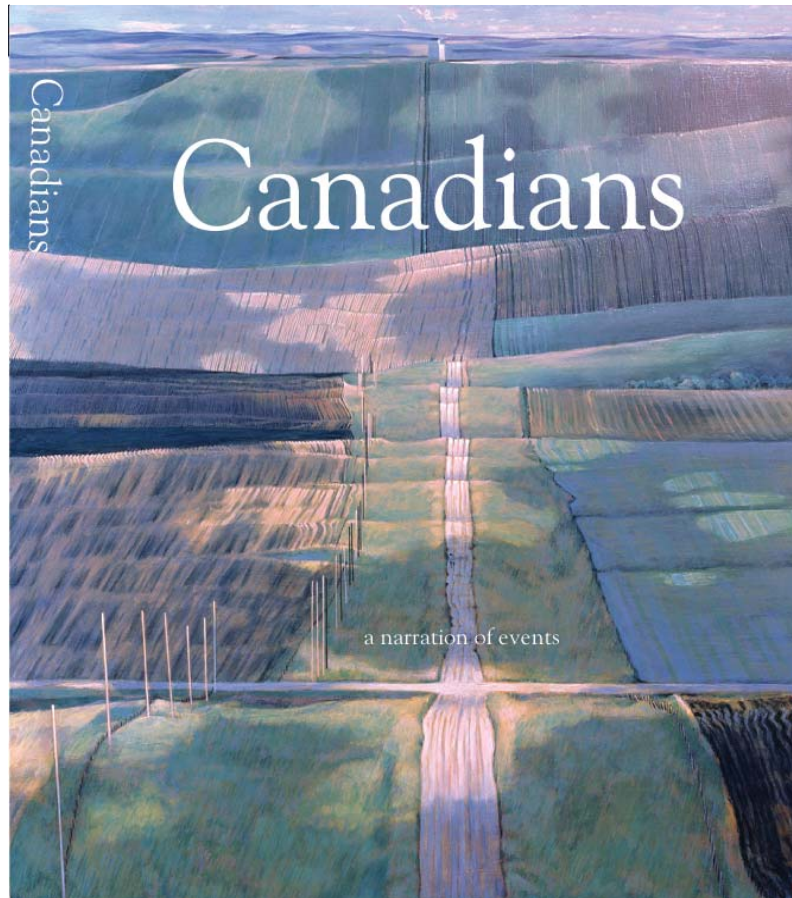


press release for the book *CANADIANS*

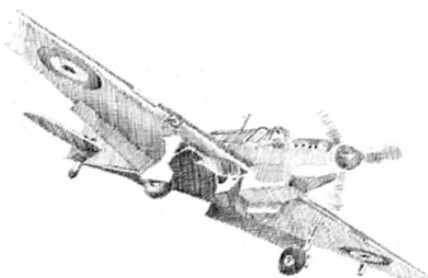
